Working specifically with students of color to understand their points of view.</li> <li>Idea for next year, smaller focus groups / 1-minute conversations with kids</li> </ul> </li> <li>Reading         <ul> <li>MCA results – reading scores will likely be down, a good indicator to show that moving reading support to 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> grades is a good decision.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Math         <ul> <li>Early indication for math MCA we will meet our goal / maybe be 9 – 10 pts higher than anticipated!</li> </ul> </li> <li>Behavior referrals         <ul> <li>950 total referrals: 174 referrals for behaviors we need to change or improve upon, 776 referrals for positive behaviors. 5.5:1 – positive behavior : negative behaviors</li> </ul> </li> </ol>

			<ul> <li>5. Attendance goals will all be hit! 95% of kids will be present and attending school for year, all subgroups were at 5, 6, 7% in absences</li> <li>6. We will have over \$350,000 volunteer hours again this year!</li> </ul>
Teacher updates	Mr. Lindskoog/ Ms. Kortuem	10 min	<ul> <li>No teacher update tonight <ul> <li>Lots of teacher activities using supply funds, field trips and appreciation for what we support.</li> <li>PTA funds used to support 4-5<sup>th</sup> grade musical buying rights of music etc.</li> <li>Alex has been working with teacher reps to clarify with teachers how to access funds / view available balance on spreadsheet</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Treasurer's Report -</li> <li>Preliminary 2024-25 Budget</li> <li>Approval of early Fall 2024 expenditures</li> <li>2024-25 budget is approved in September at the first PTA meeting</li> </ul>	Alex/Abby	20 min	<ul> <li>See attached: Discussion <ul> <li>In good shape – as above, this is the time of year when we see increased spending.</li> <li>Plant sale – numbers still coming in. Net might be slightly lower</li> <li>Proposed budget – reduce cash balance to just under \$50,000</li> <li>Review of survey overall high-level input from survey participants was to keep things relatively the same as they have been</li> <li>Goal is to have cash balance between \$30,000 - \$60,000</li> <li>September 2024 <ul> <li>We will conduct prelim vote on expenses related to readathon, teacher welcome back, spirit wear and field improvement work</li> </ul> </li> <li>Current Budget discussion: <ul> <li>Increase field trip budget</li> <li>Will have flexibility to adjust field trip budget next spring, unsure what right amount / student is, currently between \$20-\$28 / student. We will reevaluate in the fall.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Canines for change (EDL) <ul> <li>\$2000 - \$4000 request for students to work with animals to work through social / emotional, this would impact a small number of students (approx 20 x 4<sup>th</sup> / 5<sup>th</sup> graders)</li> <li>To compare:</li> </ul> </li> </ul></li></ul>

			<ul> <li>PTA supports EDL programs through lego / robotics</li> <li>Accelerated readers \$2000 / \$4000</li> <li>Rollerskating 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> grade</li> <li>Discussion about Canines for Change</li> <li>Is it a one-time / ongoing need?</li> <li>Ensure that students selected for canines for change would be students who have social / emotional challenges or have experienced trauma.</li> <li>This would be in conjunction with special education teacher</li> <li>Is there opportunity to make accessible during the school day?</li> <li>Accelerated Reader discussion         <ul> <li>Unclear who is still using accelerated reader program, what is our process for evaluating in class enrichment programs?</li> <li>Lisa Ortmann to connect w teacher reps maybe during global workshop week before 2024 schoolyear.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Field Improvement         <ul> <li>In general people support action to improve field.
